Professor S. Parthasarathy

Prof. S Parthasarathy affectionately called as BISHMAR by LIS professionals, was born in Podicherry and had his education in Madras, Delhi and Chicago Universities. He Joined INSDOC in 1952 and laid down office as the Head of INSDOC in 1977. He was a very close associate of Dr. S R Ranganathan. He was associated with many committees, such as the Committee on Developing Countries and Commission for Asia and Oceania. Professor Parthasarathy served on several bodies and Committees such as the BIS, UGC, DST, INSA and ICSSR at the National level. At the International level he has served as Vice President of the International Advisory Committee of UNESCO. He taught at Madras University and DRTC. He was a member of the Indian delegation which visited USSR and EEC in 1974-75 to study the working of their information systems. He is a Founder Trustee of the Ranganathan Centre for Information Studies and is a guiding spirit and mentor of Madras Library Association.
